Challenges of Capital Projects Sourcing

Big capital projects are inherently risky and require relatively large sums to acquire, develop, improve, or maintain an organization's capital assets. It's not surprising that supply management employees assigned to capital projects sourcing activities are uniquely qualified to be engaged in different multi-year, capital-intensive projects. Capital project activities represent about 10% of the total supply management employees assigned, but are responsible for almost 19% of the organization's total spend.
